Job Summary:

General Description of Duties:

An employee in this class performs a variety of unskilled, semi-skilled, and skilled tasks in the maintenance and repair of equipment and machinery at a wastewater treatment plant and pumping stations. Work involves performing preventive maintenance on all types of equipment; making daily rounds to lift stations and ensuring they are functioning properly; adding odor control; mowing grass; weed eating; cleaning around lift stations; checking, cleaning and repairing bar screens; checking generators and topping off fluids; changing oil; and checking valves, floats, and transducers. The position also assists the Lead Maintenance Mechanic in making more complex repairs including, but not limited to, repairing pumps, hydraulic systems, aerators, check valves, air release valves, etc.

Recruitment and Selection Guidelines:

Interested candidates will be assessed on the following knowledge, skills and abilities:

- Knowledge of the installation, repair, and maintenance of the mechanical, plumbing, and hydraulic components of wastewater treatment plants and pumping stations.
- Knowledge of the hazards and necessary safety precautions of the work being performed.
- Knowledge of the tools, parts, and methods associated with diagnosing, repairing, and maintaining equipment.
- Skill in the operation and care of equipment and tools utilized in the work.
- Ability to detect malfunctioning of pumps and motors by observation, sound, and monitoring of charts and gauges; and to take proper remedial action.
- Ability to read and understand schematic drawings and blueprints.
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with supervisors, co-workers, and the general public.
- Ability to prepare and maintain accurate records of work activities, maintain logs, and to prepare reports.
