



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE & COMMERCIAL GARBAGE/RECYCLING COLLECTION RATES

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Marion, North Carolina as follows:

Section 1. That rates for Residential Garbage Collection are hereby established as follows:

Fee per month per residence **\$5/month**

Section 2. That rates for Commercial Garbage/Recycling Collections are hereby established as follows:

Termination of Service

Service to Residential Garbage and Commercial Garbage/Recycling Collection Only customers will be terminated for nonpayment on or around the 5th day of the month following the due date. Customers will be notified by letter of termination of service. Should the account remain unpaid for ten (10) days after the date of the letter, any receptacles will be removed.



Deposits for new Residential Garbage and Commercial Garbage/Recycling Collection Only customers (does not apply when premises also has water and/or water and sewer service):

Refundable Deposit equal to one month's service fee.

Although, this deposit is for new customers, should an existing customer become delinquent to the point of having service terminated and the receptacle removed, the customer will be treated as a new customer and the deposit will be required.

Section 2. The Ordinance adopted on June 18th, 2019 is rescinded upon the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 3. All other ordinances, in conflict with this Ordinance, are rescinded upon the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective July 1, 2020.
